PINKNIC is a not for profit community event which is free to attend and is funded by donations, fund-raising events and grant applications. We therefore are not able to pay artists fees and proposing artists should be aware of this. Subject to funding we may be able to reimburse / contribute towards travel costs, this will be confirmed prior to the date if it is available. All production costs are met by us.

PINKNIC offers an opportunity to showcase work at a high profile event with an anticipated 3000+ visitors. The event is promoted through an extensive marketing campaign both in print and online.

PINKNIC hopes to be able to act as a stepping stone for emerging artists. We're fully aware that not being able to offer fees / expenses to everyone involved does mean that PINKNIC is not for everyone. However many participating artists (both emerging and established) apply each year because they've enjoyed being part of the experience and want to be involved again.

PINKNIC is always looking for volunteers to help out in many ways both before and during the event. For example by fundraising, stewarding, helping set up marquees, being part of the stage crew or filming / photographing the event. There are many opportunities for getting involved no matter what your skills are, so please don't hesitate to email us if you feel you could help out and be part of the event in any way possible.

FAQS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

WHAT TYPE OF ACTS / DISPLAYS CAN BE PROPOSED FOR THE EVENT ?

We have a number of spaces available for artists across the festival. In addition to Music / Dance / DJ performances we also welcome proposals for displays by 2D/3D visual displays, comedy and other interactive performance. If you are unsure please submit your proposal and we will see if we have a suitable space for you. Feel free to email us with any queries you may have.

WHAT AREAS CAN I PERFORM IN ?

The main performance space.

WHAT ACTS CAN'T YOU ACCEPT ?

We are unable to accept acts involving fire and juggling with weaponry (and definitely not both!). We will not accept performances of a discriminatory / offensive nature. If you have specific concerns about any element of your proposed performance / display please contact us to discuss.

WHEN WILL I FIND OUT IF MY APPLICATION HAS BEEN SUCCESSFUL ?

We will be confirming the line up in April and will contact all applicants and let them know one way or another if they have been successful.

WHAT DO ARTISTS GET IN RETURN FOR THEIR PERFORMANCE ?

Although we are unable to pay fees, artists have the opportunity to showcase their work to an anticipated attendance in excess of 3000+ people and to be included in associated event publicity.

All artists are also able to have any merchandise / CDs/DVDs / gig tickets etc. sold on the main performance stage.

I HAVE PREVIOUSLY PERFORMED AT PINKINC OR APPLIED AND BEEN UNSUCCESSFUL CAN I APPLY AGAIN ?

Yes to both. Although we will try to give preference to first time applicants to give everyone a good opportunity and keep the performances new and fresh each year, we will also be happy to welcome back popular acts from previous years.

There are many reasons we may not have accepted a previous application; please feel free to reapply this year.

CAN I CHOOSE WHAT TIME I PERFORM ?

The stage management will decide upon the line up order most suitable to the event and confirm your allocated time slot for your performance. Performances will take place at the main event between Midday and 8pm. If there are specific times you cannot perform please state this on your application and we will endeavour to work around this.

HOW DO YOU SELECT PERFORMERS ?

We will take into account a number of factors including the diversity of different acts; the quality of the proposed performances, suitability to our target audience, supporting local and emerging artists while allowing the event to benefit from the range of talent nationwide etc. There is no exact criteria other than the small number of restricted acts listed above.

We are unlikely to have the same act repeated in different areas / times across the festival. However if you have two or more different applications e.g. you are a comedian or visual artist who also sings in a band, we are happy to accept applications for both.
